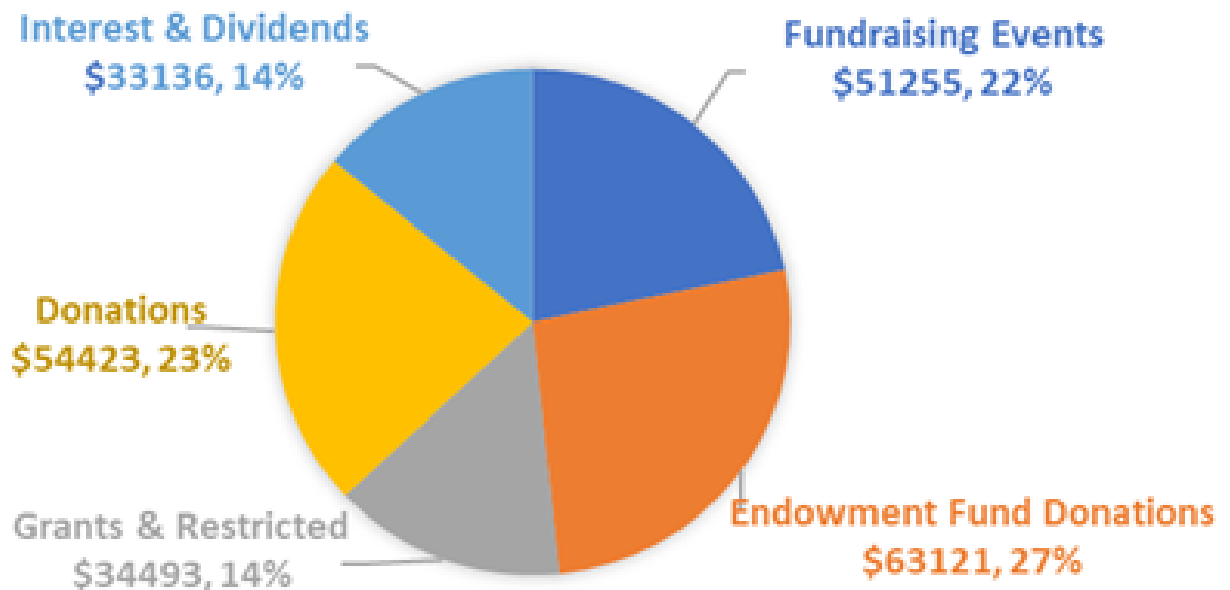

REVENUE

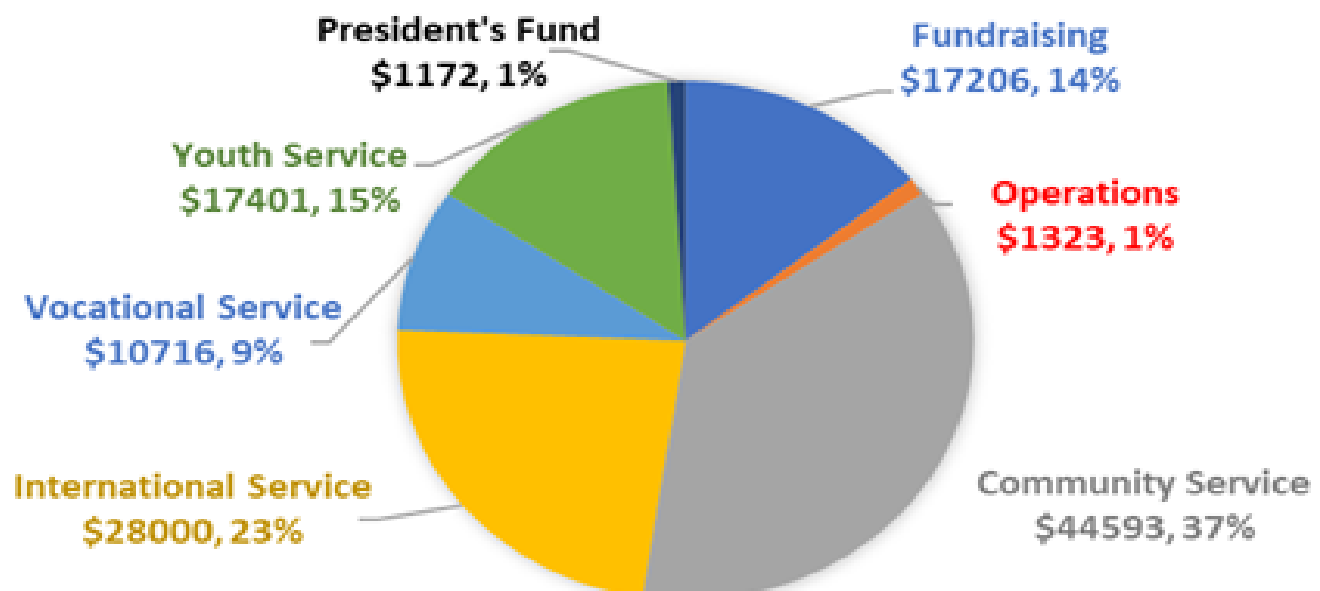
\$236,428
